Important Information Regarding Branch Allotment and Admission Process

It has come to our notice that some students who have been selected based on the merit list did not receive their first preferred branch, but were instead allotted their second, third, fourth or fifth choice. This is because seats in the preferred branches were already filled by candidates ranked higher on the merit list.

As a result, many students are choosing not to take admission. We would like to inform all candidates that branch upgradation is done automatically whenever a seat becomes available—due to non-admission or withdrawal by a higher-ranked candidate. In such cases, the vacated seat is allotted to the next eligible candidate as per the merit list.

Therefore, students who have not received their preferred branch still have a fair chance of getting it through the automatic upgradation process. However, to be considered for upgradation, it is mandatory to first take admission in the branch currently allotted.

We strongly encourage all selected candidates to confirm their admission within the stipulated time in order to remain eligible for any future branch upgradation.
